




3.3 Removing the Magazine

1) Slides open the bezel door to the right.

- 2) Press the Eject button, the player will stop playing. ("STOP" message is shown in the display). After the disc has stopped, it will display "Eject" and the magazine will be ejected.
- 3) Remove the magazine.
- 4) Close the bezel door. (When the magazine is completely ejected, monitor will prompt "No Magz" in the display).



To remove the magazine press the $extttttt} exttt{button}$ and pull out the disc magazine.

3.4 Unloading Disc

1) Pull out the tray from the magazine.

2) Remove the disc from the tray using your index finger and thumb. Avoid touching the recorded surface.

3) Push back the emptied tray until it is locked in place.

Caution: Be sure the front bezel door is closed when loading or after removing a magazine. Dust or dirt may enter the magazine may result in damage to the unit.

4 BASIC FUNCTIONS

4.1 Disc Check Operation

1) Insert magazine and disc check will start immediately.

2) Monitor will display "Disc Check XX" where XX is from 10 down to 01.

- 3) After disc check completed and if the power is ON, elevator block will extract the first available disc from the magazine and start playback. (Monitor will display "LOADING") If the power is OFF, it will get standby at chunking position.
- 4) During disc check operation, no command is allowed except POWER key.
- 5) If ACC is off, insert magazine will turn on the monitor power and start disc check operation. After completion, it will shut down the power.

4.2 DVD playback (DVD)

- 1) Press the remote control's POWER(() button or the front panel POWER (() button to switch on the unit's power.
- 2) DVD playback commences.
- · The disc will start to play if the disc does not have any menu recorded on it.
- If the disc has one or more titles recorded on it, a menu screen will appear on the TV monitor.

The DVD will display "INVALD DISC", if the DVD disc has a region code that does not tally with the unit's pre-set code.

- 3) Press * / * / * / * to select the preferred title.
- 4) Press the ENTER button, the selected item will now start playing.
- 5) Return to the menu screen.

Press the MENU or TITLE button, the menu screen will appear.

After operation, press POWER () button to put the unit into standby mode.

Note:

When "INVALID" appears, it means that the corresponding operation is prohibited either by the player or by the disc.

4.3 Audio CD or Video CD playback (CD/VCD)

1) Press the remote control's **POWER** (**6**) button or the front panel **POWER** (**6**) button to switch on the unit's power.

2) Press PLAY/PAUSE (II / ▶) button to start the playback of the disc.

Playback Video CDs with playback control Using Menus

- This function works only with Video CD with playback control (Version 2.0).
- After steps 1 to 3 as mentioned above, the menu will be displayed on the TV monitor.
- 1) Press the numeric buttons to select the preferred track.
- 2) Press the RETURN button to stop the playback and return to the Menu screen.



4.5 Next track or previous track (CD/VCD/DVD)

4.6 Play / Pause (CD/VCD/DVD)



4.7 Slow Motion play (VCD/DVD)

Each time the **SLOW** button is pressed, the unit will go into a slow motion playback mode.

4.8 Stop (CD/VCD/DVD)

- 1) During Audio CD playback, when STOP () button is pressed, the CD playback will stop.
- 2) During VCD/DVD playback, when the STOP () button is pressed, "PRE STOP" will appear. The player records the point where the STOP () button is pressed (Resume playback function).

Press the PLAY/PAUSE (II / >) button again, the play will resume from this point.

During "PRE STOP", if **STOP** () button is pressed, "STOP" will appear and the resume playback function will be cleared.



4.9 Search function (CD/VCD/DVD)





4.10 Changing the discs





4.11.2 Camera angle (DVD)

Some DVD discs may contain scenes, which have more than one viewing angle.

For these discs, the same scene can be viewed from a different angle by using the ANGLE button.





4.11.4 Subtitle (DVD)

4.11.5 DVD menu (DVD)






